system alias property file. The adapter now retrieves the configured system alias names directly from Netweaver. By default, the web.xml configuration parameter has been commented out. If required, use of the system alias property file can be enabled by uncommenting the itim.adapter.systemalias.file init-param in the adpater web.xml.
