Product overview

IBM® Security Identity Manager provides the software and services to deploy policy-based provisioning solutions. This product helps companies automate the process of provisioning employees, contractors, and business partners with access rights to the applications they need. The provisioning can be done either in a closed enterprise environment or across a virtual or extended enterprise.

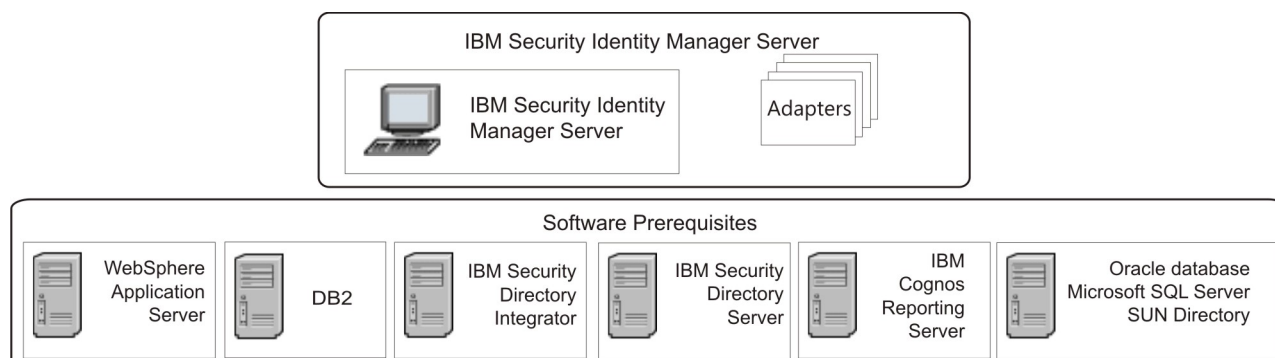

5 Step 5: Install and configure your middleware components

1. Install and configure one of the supported databases.
2. Install and configure one of the supported directory servers.
3. Install the supported version of WebSphere Application Server.
4. Install the supported version of IBM Cognos Reporting Server.

6 Step 6: Install IBM Security Identity Manager

7 Step 7: Install your adapters



Install one or more IBM Security Identity Manager adapters.
