What's in the box

The product includes:

- InfoSphere Data Architect (IDA) Business Data Model
- IDA Atomic Warehouse Model (AWM), containing System of Record entities
- IDA Dimensional Warehouse Model (DWM), including:
 - Transaction entities
 - Aggregate entities
 - Dimension entities
- InfoSphere Business Glossary (IBG) representation of:
 - Business Terms
 - Analytical Requirements
 - Supportive Content

Note: the IDA logical models are mapped to the IBG content.

Additional components comprise:

- IIW Data Domain
- IIW Logical to Physical Glossary Model

Known issues and limitations

DWM - AWM Assigned Terms error Work-around: When analyzing the IDA models with IBG Validations, errors (IBMBG300 or IBMBG304) might be raised. To fix these errors, proceed as follows for each model: 1. Right click the root package. 2. Select Analyze Model and select BG validations. 3. Run the validation. 4. Right-click one of the errors. 5. Select Quick Fix. 6. Select Update all terms whose context or name has changed. 7. Click Finished.
