### Product overview

IBM® InfoSphere™ Information Server for Data Warehousing provides the key data integration capabilities that organizations can use to understand, transform, and deliver trustworthy and context-rich information. The optional IBM InfoSphere Information Server Data Quality Pack enables organizations to profile, cleanse, and monitor the quality of information over time.

### 2 Step 2: Evaluate the system requirements



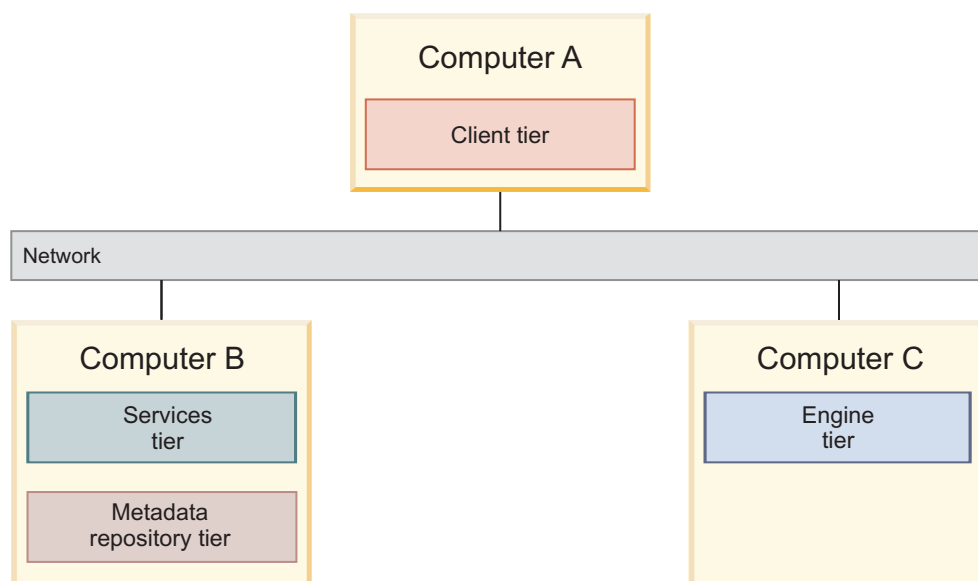
