Overview

IBM Lotus Connections 3.0 is social software designed to meet the needs of business. It empowers business professionals to be more innovative and productive by helping them build networks of subject matter experts to call upon. It facilitates the creation of vibrant communities of employees, partners, and customers where creative ideas can be exchanged that can help foster increased business growth. It also provides companies with the tools needed to help teams accomplish their business objectives whether they are located locally or distributed geographically.

New capabilities

Expanding your professional network of colleagues

Social analytics based widgets provide recommendations for people with whom you might wish to connect. The widgets also display what you have in common with an individual (for example, community membership) and the social path that links you to a person.

Providing increased flexibility with a stand-alone Forums application

Forums can now be used as a stand-alone application. This provides added flexibility in opening discussions with an entire organization on topics that are not associated with a community. Forums continue to have the ability to integrate within a community.

Growing vibrant communities

Community owners can invite individuals to join a community. Members of public communities can invite people to join the community. Community owners can create sub-communities focused on topics that are of special interest to subsets of a community. Communities can be organized to collaborate on projects by adding a subset of community members to an activity.

Locating the expertise you need

Accessing profile information is designed to be faster with an updated page navigation approach. Searching your company's directory and accessing your network contacts has been streamlined.

Staying informed whether in the office or on the go

The list of supported mobile devices is expanded, and the number of Lotus Connections applications that can be accessed from a mobile browser is expanded.

Description

IBM Lotus Connections 3.0 adds new capabilities across all of its existing applications, new social analytics capabilities, and a new Forums application for holding discussions.

Forums: The new Forums application provides increased flexibility by allowing discussion forums to take place outside of Communities. The Forums application provides a convenient way to create an online discussion board where people can ask questions, share their experiences, and discuss topics of common interest. Participating in a forum allows you to benefit from the expertise of other people through the exchange of ideas with your teammates and others who share your interest in a topic.

Social analytics widgets

New social analytics widgets are available in the Home Page, Communities, and Profiles applications and are designed to help you to:

- Expand your professional network
- Find content and communities that might interest you

A new Recommendations widget appears in the Home Page and Communities applications.

- **Recommendations:** In the Home Page application, this widget recommends content that you might find interesting based on your existing community membership, network connections, tags, and so forth. In the Communities application, the Recommendations widget suggests communities that you might want to join.

The following three new widgets appear in the Profiles application:

- **Do You Know:** This widget recommends people for you to add to your network based on your existing connections, tags, organizational relationships, and actions that you have taken in the different applications.
- **Things in Common:** This widget helps you identify what you have in common with a person. For example, the widget might display a list of the communities that you and the profile owner both belong to, or a list of the tags that you have both used.
- **Who Connects Us:** This widget allows you to view the social path that links you to a person when you are viewing that person's profile. The social path displays as a list of people who link you and the profile owner.

Home Page: The Home Page application helps provide individuals with a consolidated view of their social data from across all of the Lotus Connections applications.

The following Home Page features are new or updated:

Discovering relevant content

- A new Recommendations widget suggests content from the different applications that might interest you.
- You can use the recommendations to help you to expand your network and find content that is relevant to you.

Staying informed of updates

- The user experience is enhanced with the addition of new filtering options that make it easier for you to keep up with the latest updates.
- The My To-Do List widget has been changed from a calendar format to a list format, making it easier to quickly scan your to-do items and prioritize them as needed.

Communities: The Communities application helps individuals with a common interest, responsibility, or area of expertise to connect with each other, share information, exchange ideas, and collaborate on projects.

The following Communities features are new or updated:

Discovering, following, and contributing to communities

- A recommendations widget suggests communities for you to join based on your existing community membership, network connections, and tags.
- You can now follow communities that interest you to get the latest updates from those communities in the Home Page news feed.
- New filtering options are available on the My Communities page, which allow you to display communities that you own, are a member of, or are following.
- The new Files widget allows you to share files from the Files application with your communities, as well as upload them from your local computer.

Customizing a community

- Communities can now have sub-communities allowing members to bring added attention to selected topics.
- When creating an activity for a community, you can add a subset of members to the activity and choose the role that those members will have. This can help to focus your efforts on projects.

- When you apply a theme to a community, the theme is now also applied to the community blog, wiki, and forums, providing visual consistency when you are working with communities and community content.
- Community owners can add multiple forums to a community. Community members can also perform additional tasks, such as marking forum topics as questions.

Growing a community

- Community owners can invite people to join their community.
- Members of public communities can send invitations to people who they think might be interested in becoming community members.

Profiles: The Profiles application helps you locate the people you need by searching across your organization using keywords that help identify expertise, current projects, and responsibilities.

The following Profiles features are new or updated:

Expanding and connecting with your professional network

- The Do You Know, Things In Common, and Who Connects Us widgets help you discover what links you to other people in your organization.
- The new Directory page simplifies searching your company's directory to find the people and expertise that you need.
- A new My Network page makes your network contacts just a click away.

Navigating to the profile information you need

- Updates to the navigation in Lotus Connections allow you to navigate directly to any page in Profiles by clicking Profiles in the product navigation bar and selecting the page that you want to go to.
- The My Profile page user experience has been enhanced making it easier and faster for you to navigate between the different areas of your profile.

Keeping profile status current

- When individuals leave an organization, the administrator can set their status to inactive. When you view the profile of an inactive user, the profile owner is flagged as an inactive user and their profile photo is no longer available.

Wikis: The wikis application provides a convenient online method for teams to author content collaboratively, edit it, and then publish it. This is designed to help businesses to create content faster, and also improve its quality by utilizing input from a variety of experts.

The following wikis features are new or updated:

Customizing a wiki

- Moving pages has been made easier with a new Move Page dialog design.
- You can reorder pages by dragging and dropping them in the navigation tree.
- You can paste in content from other sources more easily with the improvements in the rich text editor.

Locating the wiki you need

- You can find a wiki by selecting Go to wiki in the search menu and typing the title.
- You can search for all public wikis and wikis you are a member of by selecting All Wikis in the search menu.
- In My wikis, a new navigation box provides a simple way to see different views of wikis. For example, you can click I'm an Owner to see wikis to which you have owner access.

- The My wikis view now has a tag cloud.

Tracking changes

- You can find pages edited by a person by opening the Index of a wiki, expanding the Pages section, and clicking Edited by.

Managing wiki membership

- A new membership view allows you to more easily control membership and access. The view has a new layout displaying role information and role filters.

Files: The Files application helps provide a fast and easy way to share files with individuals and groups. The model is simple. You upload a file of any type and add readers and editors to it.

The following Files features are new or updated:

Navigating to and following files

- Open a file or folder and click Follow to receive notification when the file or folder is updated.
- Click the thumbtack icon next to your favorite files and folders to add them to the Pinned Files or Pinned Folders views.

Contributing, organizing, and managing files

- Files can be gathered together into folders to match your projects or areas of interest.
- Files can be easily added to folders by dragging and dropping them onto a folder.
- Files can be moved to a trash view where they are not visible to others. They are not permanently deleted until you choose to empty the trash view.
- Personal files can be easily shared with a community.

Blogs: The Blogs application helps you to present your ideas, get feedback from others, and learn from the expertise and experience of others who blog.

The following Blogs features are new or updated:

Editing a blog

- A new editor makes it easier to author blog entries and enhance them with pictures and videos.
- Auto-save saves your in-progress work and reminds you when you have unsaved work so you can resume editing.

Moderating a blog

- Moderation has been significantly improved to give more control to the administrator to moderate information or to delegate the work.
- You can now assign reviewers to a moderation role so they can review flagged content.
- New configuration options allow you to assign reviewers for each category of flagged content.

Activities: The Activities application helps individuals to create online work areas where they and their teammates can gather together the emails, IM chats, documents, messages, and other information that they need to accomplish a business objective.

The following Activities features are new or updated:

Creating activities for use by a community

- You can add a community to an activity either while creating the activity or afterward.
- You can restrict access for a community activity to a subset of community members.

Locating an activity

- You can now search the tag cloud for a specific tag and multiple tags.

Bookmarks: The Bookmarks social bookmarking application helps you to save, organize, and share bookmarks as well as discover bookmarks that have been qualified by others.

The following Bookmarks features are new or updated:

- The enhanced bookmark form makes it easier to tag a bookmark and add it to another application.
- Updated notification gives you more options for notifying other users about a broken link.

Expanded support for mobile usage

Lotus Connections 3.0 expands the number of its applications that are accessible from a mobile browser. Support for mobile browser access has been added to the Lotus Connections Home Page, Bookmarks, Forums, Communities, Files, and Wikis applications.

Examples of the capabilities provided include:

- Update your status
- Add new people to your network
- Share a file
- Log into a community to post information
- Add a bookmark

The list of supported mobile devices is expanded to include the Apple iPad and devices running the Android 2.x operating system.

The Profiles, Activities, and Blog applications also continue to be supported for mobile browser access.

New API added to track data changes

A new API enables the tracking of all data changes across the Lotus Connections applications. This API can be used by software developers and application providers to provide a variety of solutions that integrate with Lotus Connections.

New API added for moderation

Lotus Connections 2.5 introduced the concept of moderation for end-user generated content in blogs. With Connections 3.0, a new API has been added to enhance existing capabilities for blogs as well as extend the moderation capabilities to community Files and Forums. This API can be used by developers and application providers to provide moderation solutions including pre-moderation (inappropriate language filter) and post-moderation (content flagging by users) among other capabilities.

Charge metrics definitions

Authorized User

Authorized User is the unit of measure by which this program is licensed. An Authorized User is an individual (named or unnamed) within or outside of your enterprise. The program may be installed on one or more computers or servers and accessed by the number of users authorized by the Proof of Entitlement (PoE). You must have an entitlement for each Authorized User accessing the program or any program component in any manner directly or indirectly (for example, via a multiplexing program, device, or application server) through any means.

Processor Value Unit (PVU)
