#### **Product overview**

IBM® Tivoli® Storage Manager for Mail automates the data protection of email servers that run either IBM Domino® or Microsoft Exchange. The product uses the email application programming interfaces (APIs) to back up and restore online business-critical data.

## 3 Step 3: Installing Tivoli Storage Manager for Mail



Insert the product DVD into the DVD drive and complete these tasks depending on the operating system:

- For Microsoft Windows: Double-click the setup.exe file and click **OK**. Follow the installation instructions.
- For IBM AIX®: Log in by using the root user ID. Go to the directory where the installation files were extracted and enter the command smitty installation at the command line. Press Enter and follow the installation instructions. Specify the AIX DVD device name as the input device and modify any remaining SMIT menu options.
- For Linux: Log in by using the root user ID. Go to the directory where the installation files were extracted and enter the name of the installation file *file name*.bin at the command line. Press Enter and follow the installation instructions.
