Product overview

IBM® Tivoli® Storage FlashCopy® Manager provides the tools and information that you need to create and manage volume-level snapshots on snapshot-oriented storage systems. Optionally, when you use Tivoli Storage FlashCopy Manager with other Tivoli Storage Manager products you can back up data to Tivoli Storage Manager storage.

1 Step 1: Access the software and documentation

3 Step 3: Installing Tivoli Storage FlashCopy Manager



Insert the product DVD into the DVD drive and complete these tasks depending on the operating system:

- For Microsoft Windows systems, complete the following steps:
 1. Log on by using the administrator ID. If autorun is enabled, the installation window starts automatically when the DVD is loaded. Otherwise, click **Start** > **Run** and enter `x:\setupfcm.exe` where `x` is the DVD drive.
 2. Follow the installation instructions to complete the installation.
- For UNIX and Linux systems, complete the following steps:
 1. Log in to the production server by using the root user ID.
 2. Go to the directory where the installation files were extracted. Depending on the installation method, enter one of the following commands:
 - Graphical installation wizard (requires an X Window System): `./4.1.0.0-TIV-TSFCM-[OS-platform].bin`
 - Command-line console wizard: `./4.1.0.0-TIV-TSFCM-[OS-platform].bin -i console`
 3. Follow the instructions to complete the installation.
- For Tivoli Storage FlashCopy Manager for VMware systems, complete the following steps:
 1. Log in to the Linux virtual machine or the Linux system by using the root user ID.
 2. Go to the directory where the installation files were extracted. Depending on the installation method, enter one of the following commands:
 - Graphical installation wizard (requires an X Window System): `./4.1.0.0-TIV-TSFCM-VMware.bin`
 - Command-line console wizard: `./4.1.0.0-TIV-TSFCM-VMware.bin -i console`
 3. Follow the instructions in the wizard to complete the installation.
